Theme “Collaboration for Sustainable Development in the Intelligent Age: Paving the Way for Solutions to New Global Challenges”

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA), Bangkok, Thailand**

1. Overview

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) was founded on April 1, 1966, in Thailand. It is a higher education institution that aims to meet the country’s developmental requirements. NIDA provides programs for postgraduate students at the master’s and doctoral levels, prioritizes top-notch research, and offers academic services with commitment. Currently, NIDA offers studies in various development administration fields, consisting of Public Administration, Business Administration, Development Economics, Applied Statistics, Social Development, Environmental Management, Language and Communication, Human Resource Development, Law, Integrated Tourism Management, Communication Arts and Management Innovation, and Business Management.

Over the past consecutive years, NIDA has been hosting three significant annual conferences: The National Conference (celebrated on the institute’s anniversaries), the International Conference on Advancement of Development Administration – Social Sciences and Interdisciplinary Studies (NIDA ICADA-SSIS), and the NIDA International Conference for Case Studies on Development Administration (NIDA-ICCS). These conferences aim to disseminate academic work, foster knowledge-sharing and idea exploration, and demonstrate research that contributes to the country’s development.

Last year, NIDA proudly organized the conference in partnership with East China Normal University (ECNU) and six other esteemed partner organizations, all in celebration of NIDA’s 58th anniversary. Under the theme "Redesigning Our Common Future for Sustainable Transformation," the conference took place on August 22-23, 2024 at our campus in Bangkok, Thailand. Highlights of the agenda included four inspiring keynote addresses from distinguished speakers: 1) Prof. Justin Yifu Lin, Ph.D., Peking University, China 2) Prof. Peter Warr, Ph.D., Australian National

University, Australia 3) Prof. Yongyuth Yuthavong, Ph.D., Thailand, and 4) Adjunct Prof. Krisana Kraisintu, Ph.D., Ramon Magsaysay Awardee, 2009. In addition to these keynote presentations, we were fortunate to host numerous experts from various organizations, contributing to a rich program of special addresses. We also saw an impressive participation of over 175 national and international academic articles, including teaching case studies, research presentations, and Ph.D. consortium presentations. The conference served as a vibrant platform for academics, professionals, and students to showcase their research on an international stage, attracting a total of 2,404 interested attendees from Thailand and around the world.

This year, NIDA is organizing the 4th NIC-NIDA Conference in 2025 under the theme **“Collaboration for Sustainable Development in the Intelligent Age: Paving the Way for Solutions to New Global Challenges.”** This theme underscores the importance of revising our path towards a future focused on equity and environmental sustainability. The conference, taking place on August 28-29, 2025, at the National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) in Bangkok, Thailand, will feature keynote and plenary lectures, as well as panel and roundtable discussions delivered by academics specializing in the mentioned disciplines.

3. Conference Objectives

1. To provide a platform for researchers, academics, professionals, and student scholars, both nationally and internationally, to discuss Sustainable Development and Sustainable Transformation.
2. To promote the creation and sharing of research in various fields related to development administration, with a special focus on sustainable development, benefiting education, management, and the country's economic, social, and political progress.

3. To support the production and sharing of academic work by NIDA lecturers in the 12 development administration fields, allowing them to present their work to the public.
4. To create an academic environment for scholars from different institutions to exchange ideas, build relationships, and engage in constructive interactions.
5. To offer a platform for academics, professionals, and university students to showcase their research at an international level.
6. To bring together experts and scholars from diverse development administration fields to discuss practical teaching case studies.

7. Types of Articles for Presentations

This conference aims to provide a platform, both nationally and internationally, for academics, researchers, managers, industrial participants, and students to exchange their research findings with global experts. All full paper submissions will undergo peer review, assessing their originality, technical or research depth, accuracy, and relevance to conference themes. Various types of articles are accepted, including:

1. Research Articles
2. Academic Articles
3. Review Articles
4. Teaching Case Studies
5. Research Case Studies
6. Thesis (Ph.D. Consortium program)

7.1 Abstract Presentations

Authors are encouraged to submit only abstracts for presentation at the 4th NIC-NIDA Conference in 2025. Those with accepted abstracts will have the opportunity to present at the conference and will be included in the conference document, not the Proceedings. In this conference, full paper submission is not required.

Kindly submit your abstract for evaluation by the NIC- NIDA Committee. Upon acceptance, authors can proceed with registering for the Conference.

Abstract Publication

The abstracts presented at the 4th NIC-NIDA Conference in 2025 will be included in the proceedings 2025.

7.2 Full Paper Presentations

Full papers will be eligible for inclusion in the Proceedings and Journals if the authors:

1. Submit both their abstracts and full papers by the specified deadline of June 15, 2025.
2. Have their work reviewed by selected reviewers.
3. Present at the conference.

Authors whose articles receive recognition as top papers or case studies through peer review will receive a certificate.

Please note that submitting a manuscript indicates it is not being considered for publication elsewhere.

The publication of full papers is subject to the guidelines, terms, and conditions set forth by the specific journals. The decision for publication ultimately rests with the review boards of these journals.

Only authors whose works meet the criteria of the conference committee and journal editors will be invited to present at the conference and have their papers published in the journal. The criteria include:

1. Submission of the full paper within the deadline.
2. Selection of the paper by the review committee
3. Participation in the morning sessions and the scheduled presentation

Additionally, articles that meet the criteria of the conference are eligible for the Top Paper Awards 2025 except those submitted during the extended period.

Please note that the theses from the Ph.D. Consortium program are not governed by these conditions.

10. Presentation Guidelines

For the Oral Presentation at the 4th NIC-NIDA Conference 2025, please adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Download the template for Full Papers/Abstracts.
2. Use the provided template to complete your full paper.
3. Register, pay the registration fee, and submit your full paper by June 15, 2025.
4. Acceptance notifications will be sent via email starting from February 20, 2025.
5. Room assignments and presenter schedules will be communicated either on <https://conference.nida.ac.th/> or via email.
6. We recommend a 25-minute talk followed by a 5-minute Q&A session. The oral presentations will begin at 1:00 p.m. onwards.

11. Articles for Submission

11.1 International Full Paper/Case Study Submission:

- Full papers or case studies should adhere to the format provided in the "Paper Template" section.
- Submissions for full papers or case studies must be done through the website <https://conference.nida.ac.th/> or QR Code within the specified deadlines and in attached file(s) in MS Word format only.
- The abstract should be between 150 to 250 words, and full papers should range from 15 to 25 pages (excluding references), with 3 to 5 keywords.

11.2 International Ph.D. Consortium Submission:

- Open to Ph.D. students in the middle of their program or working on their research proposal.
- Presenters need to have their research papers approved by their advisors to present at the conference.
- Presenters will receive a certificate from the organizer, and there is no requirement to publish their papers.
- Submissions should be done through the website <https://conference.nida.ac.th/> or by scanning the QR Code.
- The Ph.D. Consortium is focused on presentations only, and there is no obligation to publish papers.

12. Format Instructions

All full papers, including case studies, should be written in English following the APA format available at <http://www.apa.org/>. It is important to use correct grammar. Full papers must be submitted by the specified deadlines. Papers that do not meet English language standards will not be considered.

13. Certificates and Awarded Papers

For Full Papers/Case Studies:

- Each presenter will receive a certificate following their presentation.
- All full papers are eligible for the “Top Paper Award.” The best paper will be granted the “Top Paper Award” and will receive:

1. Certificate for Top Paper Award.
2. 5,000 Thai baht (approximately 10 papers will be awarded. Please note that the committee's decision is final).

For the Ph.D. Consortium:

- Presenters will receive a certificate from the organizer without any requirement to publish their papers.
