1. Overview

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) was established on April 1, 1966. It is an institution of higher education in Thailand that has produced personnel to meet the country's developmental needs. It offers graduate programs at the master's and doctoral levels, promotes the conducting of high-quality research and continuously provides academic services to the public with dedication and passion. At present, it offers studies in fields related to development administration, namely Public Administration, Business Administration, Development Economics, Applied Statistics, Social Development, Environmental Management, Language and Communication, Human Resource Development, Law, Integrated Tourism Management, Communication Arts and Management Innovation, and Business Management.

Over the years, NIDA has annually organized three major conferences, consisting of the National Conference (held on the Institute's anniversaries), the International Conference on Advancement of Development Administration - Social Sciences and Interdisciplinary Studies (NIDA ICADA-SSIS) and the NIDA International Conference for Case Studies on Development Administration (NIDA-ICCS). These conferences share three objectives which are to disseminate works of academics both in and outside NIDA, provide forums for sharing knowledge and exploring ideas, and present research that benefits the country's development.

This year, NIDA deems it appropriate to organize the 2nd NIC-NIDA Conference which combines the national and international academic conferences with the case studies forum. The conference is on “New Frontiers of Sustainable Development” and will be hosted at the National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA), Bangkok, Thailand and online on August 17 - 18, 2023 (the online platform is for presenters and participants outside Thailand only). The main

activities include keynote and plenary lectures, panel and roundtable discussions and academic presentations related to sustainable development in line with this year's theme "New Frontiers of Sustainable Development through Designing and Implementing Re-globalization" encompassing the areas of Economics, Society and Governance and Environment from speaker. The keynote lectures and presentations will be delivered by academics from the 11 disciplines as stated above.

2. Conference Theme

"New Frontiers of Sustainable Development through Designing and Implementing Re-globalization"

3. Conference Objectives

- (1) Be a platform that brings together researchers, academics, professionals, scholars and university students, national or international, to exchange their views and share their insights on the Re-Globalization for Sustainable Development.
- (2) Promote the production and dissemination of research works in various fields relating to development administration.
- (3) Provide a public stage where academic, professional and student participants can present their research at the international level.
- (4) Promote the growth of research and development, and teaching and policy suggestions in the economic, social and governance realms.
- (5) Broaden social networks among academics from both local and international institutions, which could lead to initiation of new or further cooperation among them as well as support from agencies in both private and public sectors.

NIC-NIDA welcomes academic works related to development and administration, social sciences, and interdisciplinary studies with the major theme of "Re-Globalization for Sustainable Development: New Frontiers of Environment, Economics, Society and Governance" The academic works can be categorized into 2 categories: (1) the disciplines/fields, and (2) the authors. All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. The organizing committee will also select the quality papers for publication in the two NIDA journals:

1) NIDA Development Journal (Indexed in TCI, Tier 3)

2) NIDA Case Research Journal (Indexed in TCI, Tier 2)

The selection is subject to the rules, terms, and conditions of the stated journals. The final decision for publication will be made by the journals' review boards. Only the authors of qualified works will be invited to give a presentation at the conference and publish in the NIDA Development Journal and NIDA Case Research Journal or if (1) the author(s) submit both his/her abstract(s) and full paper(s) by the due dates, (2) their works are peer reviewed and qualified by the selected reviewers, and (3) the author(s) give his/her/their presentations at the conference.

Also, a certificate will be presented to the author(s) whose article(s) has been peer-reviewed and awarded as a top paper/top case study. These papers will be published in the NIDA Development Journal and NIDA Case Research Journal.

Oral Presentation: In the 2nd NIC-NIDA Conference 2023 presenters are required to follow these guidelines:

- 1) Download template for a full paper
- 2) Complete a full paper by using the given template.
- 3) Register, pay the registration fee, and submit a full paper by June 15, 2023
- 4) Notification of acceptance will be sent via email by March 30, 2023

(onwards) via email.

5) The room numbers and order of presenters will be announced on <http://conference.nida.ac.th/>

6) You are encouraged to have a 30-minutes talk and a 5 minutes Q&A afterwards. The oral presentation starts at 13.00 onwards.

11. Article for Submission

11.1 International Full Paper/ Case Study Submission:

- Full Paper/Case Study must be written according to the format given in the “The paper template” section.

- Full Paper/Case Study submission must be made via website <http://conference.nida.ac.th/> or QR Code and within the given due dates and as the attached file(s) in the MS Word format only.

- The minimum and maximum length of both an abstract is 150 - 250 words, that of a full paper no longer than 15-25 pages (excluding tables, appendices, and references) and keywords of 3-5 words.

11.2 International Ph.D. Consortium Submission:

- Students who are midway through their Ph.D.

- In the process of research proposal (Thesis)

- Presenters must submit their research papers to their advisors for endorsement and approval to be eligible to present at the conference.

- Presenters will be awarded a certificate by the organizer without any obligation to publish their papers.

- Submission must be made via website <http://conference.nida.ac.th/> or QR Code.

- Ph.D. Consortium is activity for presentations only, without any obligation to publish their papers.

All full paper (including case studies) must be typed in English and in the APA format only (<http://www.apa.org/>). The language use must be grammatically correct. Full papers must be submitted by the given due dates. Full papers with poorly written English will not be considered.

13. Certificates and Awarded Papers

For Full Paper/ Case Study: Each presenter will get a certificate after their presentation. All full papers are eligible for “Top Paper Award” and the best paper will be awarded “**Top Paper Award**” and will get

(1) Certificate for Top Paper Award

(2) 5,000 baht (Thai) *Awarded Papers is around 8 Papers*

For Ph.D. Consortium: The presenters will be awarded a certificate by the organizer without any obligation to publish their papers.
